



2008 Pakistan Earthquake Relief

Situation Overview

On Wednesday Oct. 29, 2008, a strong 6.4 magnitude earthquake struck Balochistan, the South-Western province of Pakistan with surrounding areas of Ziarat being the worst hit. In the villages of Wam Kotel and Wam Killa 90km from Quetta, all of the houses have been destroyed, and the village of Warchoom, almost 70% of homes have been destroyed. The locals of this region are already known to be very poor, and now it is estimated that 35,000 people are now homeless due to this disaster.

Hidaya's Response

Hidaya sent out a four-member advance team within hours of the earthquake which reached the following morning to the disaster region. The team assessed damages and made arrangements for relief aid to be distributed effectively. Within 48 hours, an additional six team members reached with relief supplies which included:

- 200 winter tents
- 12,000 pounds of winter clothing (sufficient for 2000 families)
- 250 bags of dry ration (totalling over 11,000 lbs of flour, over 2750 lbs of lentils, over 1100 lbs of sugar, and over 130 lbs of tea)

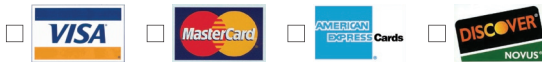
