What are the Rewards of **Giving Ourbani?**

The companions of Allah's Messenger (peace be upon him) asked him the significance of these sacrifices and he replied, "It is a custom which has come down from your father, Abraham (pbuh)". They asked what reward they would receive for them and he replied, "For every hair you will receive a blessing". They asked about wool, and he replied, "For every strand of wool you will receive a blessing". (Al-Tirmidhi #1476)

What are the Basic **Requirements for Ourbani?**

Qurbani is wajib on all Muslims, male and female who are sane, adult, and posess nisab (zakatable wealth).

The animal to be sacrificed must be a goat, sheep, cattle or camel (male or female) and must be of the right age. A camel must be at least 5 years old, cattle 2 years old, and a goat or sheep 1 year old; However a very healthy sheep or ram that looks one year old may also be used. Castrated and barren animals may be used for Ourbani. The animal must be free from any form of handicap such as blindness, sickness, a limp or undernourishment. Finally the animal must be slaughtered in an appropriate and humane way. For complete information on Ourbani, visit www.hidaya.org/gurbani.

How does Hidaya Distribute • Ourbani orders are accepted untill **Ourbani Meat?**

Project proposals are documented which describe in detail how the team will be distributing meat. At times, people come to Hidaya's distribution centers to pick up Ourbani meat whereas in other locations, the Hidaya team goes house to house to distribute the meat. Quite often, tokens are issued to families who are identified to receive meat. 1 kg mutton or 2 kg beef packages are exchanged for the tokens.

Who Does Hidaya Distribute Ourbani Meat to?

Ourbani arranged by Hidaya helps the poor in South Asia, West Africa and North America, such as orphans, widows, survivors of natural disaster, sick, elderly, Masakeen (persons of extreme poverty who posess no wealth whatsoever) and Fugaraa (those who own property in excess of basic necessities but below the value of Nisab).

What is the Cost of Qurbani this Year?

The cost of Qurbani includes: animal cost, transportation, feed, sacrifice, and distribution. Any remaining funds are used towards Hidaya's operational overhead costs.

Important Ourbani Information

- Best way to offer Qurbani is to perform it by ones own self. For those not able to fullfill this obligation, Hidaya assists by performing Qurbani on their behalf.
- Sacrifice is arranged after the Eid Salat has been performed in the U.S.
- 9:00pm PST on the 2nd day of Eid.
- Orders received by mail after 3 days of Eid will be distributed as Sadagah, unless prior notification is given to Hidava.

Sadagah in the Form of **Sacrifice**

A man called the Apostle of Allah (pbuh): We used to sacrifice Atirah in pre-Islamic days during Rajab; so what do you command us? He (pbuh) said: Sacrifice for the sake of Allah in any month whatever; obey Allah, Most High, and feed (the people). (Abu-Dawood #2824)

Hidaya Foundation does Sadagah in the form of Sacrifice as a year round project. Hidaya can do a sacrifice and distribute meat to the poor within just 72 hours of your request.

It costs \$75 each for a goat/sheep and \$280 each for an ox/buffalo. During 2007 Hidaya has arranged sadaqa in the form of sacrifice of over 300 goats and 30 ox/buffalo internationally. For U.S. prices, contact us.


