The spread of basic general education among the poor in rural populations is one of Hidaya's priorities. The **Spread Education** project is divided among the following sub-projects:

Support Poor Students: Hidaya Foundation identifies motivated students from primary school to university levels, who are not in a position to continue their education because of financial hardships and provides them with partial assistance or full financial support.

Female Education Drop-out Prevention: Hidaya strongly believes that females need to be properly educated as they are the future mothers of the next generation and therefore the most important building block of our societies. **Just \$6 per month** is enough to offer one student the opportunity to continue her education and bring a remarkable change to her life and in time, many such cases can bring positive change to the larger society.

Adult Education: Illiteracy is not only a concern for the young but also among adults. Hidaya strives to teach adults basic education such as reading, writing, basic arithmetic, and more.

Language Competency: Hidaya assists the poor by teaching them competency in their local language along with English, so that they may have more options when seeking employment.

Sports & Fitness Training: Hidaya will be organizing various youth sports leagues and competitions in poor & rural areas of Pakistan. There are many benefits of such activities such as fostering teamwork among young children, providing them with positive environments and providing good adult role models.
