School Supplies

Educational Books, Notebooks, Coloring Books, Backpacks, Colored Pencils/Crayons/Markers

Children's Toys

Toys that are in good condition

Household Items

Pots & Pans, Dishes, Tents, Tarps, Tools

Medical Equipment

Wheel Chairs, Crutches, Walkers, Braces/Splints, Wraps, Medicines

Items We Cannot Accept*

Electrical Appliances, Furniture, CRT Monitors, Broken Items, Food, Bicycles, Islamic Literature

*Based upon need, shipping/customs constraints

How to Donate Your Items

Bagging/Boxing Instructions:

BAGS

- Use thick trash bags for soft items (clothes, blankets, sleeping bags, stuffed animals)
- Make sure all bags are tied/sealed so nothing can fall out with no rips or tears
- Fill Boxes with all Hard Items (toys, dishes*, pots & pans, tools)
- *Please pack dishes tightly in a box with newspapers or clothes
- Make sure box is strong, packed tightly, and full
- Bags and Boxes are available at Hidaya's warehouse if needed

Who will pay the Shipping Costs?

Hidaya Foundation asks that our donors kindly chip in with an additional monetary donation along with their in-kind items by paying **\$1 per pound** for shipping costs.
