

Hidaya Foundation is working with its partner, Hidaya Trust, to deliver food, medicine, temporary shelter and more to families affected by floods in Pakistan. We will also be helping with rebuilding projects after waters recede, in shaa Allah.



Hidaya is working on the following fronts to bring short and long term relief to affected families with an estimated cost of over \$6 Million.

Food Distribution

- Dry ration packages containing wheat or rice, chickpeas, cooking oil, soap for hygiene are being distributed, costs \$50 per family.
- Currently over 10,000 people are being provided cooked food (beef/fish or vegetable biryani) daily. Goal is to ramp up distribution to over 54,000 people daily and to continue distribution for next 2 months. It costs around \$50 to cook and distribute a pot of beef/fish biryani (18 kg) enough to feed 90 people. It costs around \$25 to cook and distribute a pot of vegetable biryani (18 kg) enough to feed 90 people. Estimated cost for this effort is \$900,000.
- Locally available vegetables and fruits including onions, potatoes, tomatoes, banana, and apples are being purchased and distributed.
- In the process of importing 25 containers of Chickpeas (625 tons) from Turkey. Estimated cost for this is \$750,000.
- In the process of importing 30 containers of cooking oil (120,000 5-liter bottles) from Indonesia. Estimated cost for this is \$850,000.

Tarps

- Tarps in stock and locally purchased are already being distributed to affected families. Additionally, to prepare for winter, over 30,000 additional tarps worth \$360,000 have been ordered from China.
- Small tarps (4x6 meter, 180 gsm) for \$15 each and large tarps (10x10 meter, 180 gsm) for \$50 each will be distributed.

Medical Assistance

- Medicines for fever, pain, gastric disorders, diarrhea, antibiotics, allergies, skin rashes, etc. are being purchased constantly and dispatched to field operations for distribution.
- Feminine hygiene products will be distributed to women.

Clothing Distribution

- In the process of sending around 20 containers of donated winter and regular clothing from the USA to Pakistan via our Container Shipment for In-Kind Donations project.
- Each container will cost around \$10,000 to ship and can clothe approximately 6,000 families (8 pieces in each bag).

Cots for Sleeping

- For several years, Hidaya has been distributing cots to families so they may sleep comfortably off the ground and avoid rodents, insects and snake bites. We will like to distribute around 5,000 cots to villagers. Each cot costs around \$50. Estimated cost for this effort is \$250,000.

Quilts and Pillows

- With their homes destroyed, families are faced with a grim winter season ahead. We will like to distribute 2 quilts and 4 pillows each to around 50,000 families, each set costing around \$16 (Rs 3,500). A portion of the quilts will be produced in-house at our female adult center using quilt making machines. Estimated cost for this effort is \$800,000.

Rebuild Homes, Masajid, Schools

- Hidaya supports over 13,000 orphans and over 6,000 widows on a monthly basis with cash assistance in Pakistan, a majority of whose mud homes in Sindh province have been destroyed. To rebuild a house of 700 sq. ft. costs around \$4,000 (Rs. 840,000). Goal is to rebuild 100 houses at an estimated cost of \$400,000.
- To rebuild a 500 sq. ft. load-bearing Masjid/Community Center for 50 people costs around \$4,650 (Rs 1,000,000). Goal is to rebuild 100 masjid at an estimated cost of \$465,000.
- To rebuild a school with 5 classrooms of 320 sq. ft. each and boundary wall costs around \$11,650 (Rs. 2,500,000). Goal is to rebuild 50 schools at an estimated cost of \$582,500.

Small Businesses for the Poor

- Push Carts - in order to create jobs and self-employment for people, we will like to distribute over 1,000 push carts to those affected by floods. Each push cart costs around \$200. Estimated cost for this effort is \$200,000.
- Sewing Machines - Hidaya has been distributing sewing machines for the last several years to create jobs. We will like to distribute 5,000 sewing machines along with a stand, electric motor, and a chair. Each set will cost around \$120. Estimated cost for this effort is \$600,000.

School Supplies for Students

- Most school supplies of students were destroyed along with their homes. We will like to provide notebooks, slates, pencils, erasers, sharpeners, etc. to students so they may continue with their education.
- In the process of importing notebooks and stationary items from China. Estimated cost for this effort is \$200,000.

Farmer Assistance

- Most of the crops of farmers have been destroyed due to floods. We will be providing seeds and fertilizers to over 10,000 farmers to regrow their crops.

Animal Farming

- A great number of livestock have perished in the floods. We will be providing sheep, chicken and ducks to families.
- It costs around \$240 for a pair of sheep and \$50 for poultry.

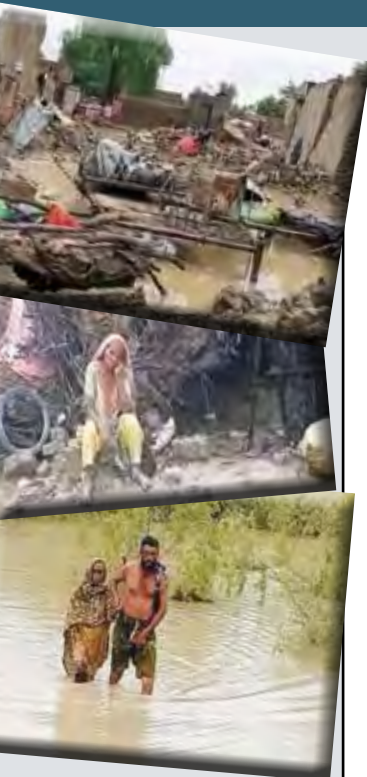
Water Hand Pumps

- As families are displaced due to floods, Hidaya will be installing water hand pumps in places where people have gathered while they wait for waters to recede.
- It costs around \$300 to install a water hand pump.
