Hidaya's Mission Statement:

To implement educational, environmental, social welfare, and health care programs in economically depressed areas of Asia, Africa and North America, with focus on projects which promote self employment.

Hidaya Foundation's Programs Overview

Education

No Orphan without Education: For just \$10 per month, all educational needs are met for an orphan child. This initiative is implemented as part of the Widow/Orphan Support project.

Support Hidaya Schools: Hidaya opens schools in rural areas which have none. It costs about \$200 to run a classroom of approximately 40 students each month.

Support Poor Students: Partial and full assistance is provided to students in need from primary school to university levels.

Hidaya Institute of Science & Technology: School children are offered courses in basic computer skills. Software engineering graduates are offered software development training.

Hidaya Institute of Farming & Agriculture: Youth from villages are trained in modern agriculture practices.

Job Skills Training: The poor are supported and trained in Sewing, Driving, and more.

Health Care

Medical Assistance: Underprivileged patients are supported for doctor visits, lab tests, surgeries and medicine. Also, hospitals in under developed areas are given medical equipment, medicines and financial support.

Environment

Clean Drinking Water: Clean drinking water is provided for the poor by installing water hand pumps or by delivering water to the masses via water tankers. A water hand pump costs \$300, and 1,200 gallons of water delivered by tanker costs approximately \$10.

One Million Trees: Hidaya grows seedlings in our own nurseries then plants them with the help of students and farming communities to improve the environment while educating poor communities about the benefits of trees. It costs just \$1 to plant each seedling.

Green Energy: Alternative energy solutions are implemented and experimented by Hidaya, with the goal of passing on affordable solutions to the masses. Hidaya currently utilizes solar energy at most of its offices and some schools.

Self Employment

Animal Farming: Poor families are given cows, goats, chickens or rabbits so they may farm and benefit from milk, eggs, meat, etc. It costs about \$450 for a cow, \$250 for a pair of goats, or \$50 for a flock of 10 chicks or a few rabbits with feeding supplies and cage.

Farmer Assistance: Farmers are provided seeds, fertilizer and pesticides to stand on their own feet and break out of the ongoing poverty cycle.

Small Businesses for the Poor: Individuals are supported under two sub-projects so they may become self-dependent: Sewing Machines to Women (\$100 for sewing machine and accessories) & Tools for Various Professions (\$200-\$1500 for a push-cart and supplies for a street vending business, \$100 to \$200 to set-up a retail shop, \$50 to \$200 for rice mill, powder crusher, straw cutter, juicer, etc).

Social Welfare

Zakat (Obligatory Charity): Zakat deserving are given cash, dry ration, clothing, and more.

Sadaqah (Charity): Assistance is given to the deserving in the form of cash, dry ration, clothing, and more.

Widow/Orphan Support: Cash stipend is given to meet all basic survival needs of widows and orphan children. Around \$40 per month can help each widow and her orphan(s).

One Million Meals: Dry ration food is given to the poor. When buying in bulk, a meal costs only 50 cents.

Sadaqah Meat (Sadaqah Sacrifice): Fresh meat is provided to the poor from ox/buffalo, goat/sheep, chicken, rabbit and fish.

Marriage Support: Assistance is provided for orphaned and poor young women. It costs approximately \$200 - \$300 for each marriage.

Container Shipment Project for In-Kind Donations: In USA, clothing, computers, books, toys, household items, and more are collected and shipped overseas to benefit the poor.

Disaster Relief: Families in emergency or catastrophic situations, such as droughts, hurricanes, earthquakes, tsunamis and floods are given assistance.

Aqiqah: Sacrifice at the time of a child's birth is carried out and meat is distributed to the poor.

Sadaqat-ul-Fitr: Dry ration food is given to the poor so they can enjoy Eid-ul-Fitr.

Qurbani/Udhiya: Arrangements are made for sacrifice of animals and distribution of meat to the poor at the time of Eid-ul-Adha.

Fidya: Dry ration is given to poor as compensation on behalf of donors who could not fast during Ramadan.

Kaffara: Dry ration is arranged for the poor on behalf of donors as an expiation for wrong actions.

Car Donations: Donated cars are fixed and given to local families and individuals in need in Northern California (Hidaya's Headquarters)

Qurbani/Udhiya is performed by Hidaya on behalf of donors and is distributed among the Masakeen (persons of extreme poverty who possess no wealth whatsoever) and Fuqaraa (those who own property in excess of basic necessities but below the value of Nisab). Qurbani/Udhiya is performed in Asia and Africa. Prices include rising prices of animals due to qurbani season hike up, transportation and feed for animals, slaughter and preparation of meat, distribution of meat to the poor, and project management costs.
